<p>EXAMPLE:</p> <p>commence</p>	<p>common</p>	<p>start, begin, get the ball rolling</p>	<p>Class will <u>commence</u> with a warm-up.</p>	
<p>denotation (noun)</p>		<p>dictionary definition</p>		
<p>connotation (noun)</p>		<p>the idea or feeling of a word, in addition to its literal meaning; overtone; undercurrent;</p>		
<p>credibility (noun)</p>		<p>quality of being believable or worthy of trust</p>		

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relevant (adj.)		connected to the matter or subject at hand; appropriate; linked; applicable		
irrelevant (adj.)		NOT connected/related to the subject; unrelated; off the subject.		
allusion (noun)		a reference to something (often literary, historical, or biblical).		
evidence (noun)		something that provides proof		
source (noun)		a book, statement, person, or other reference supplying information
